



Police Officer

The City of Rupert is accepting applications for an position of police officer. This position performs law enforcement, crime investigation and crime prevention work. Duties normally consist of patrol and traffic activities within the city limits on assigned shifts.

Minimum qualifications include being 21 years of age, a high school graduate or GED, U.S. citizen, and possession of a valid driver's license. Applicants must meet the physical requirements for a law enforcement officer as prescribed by the Idaho Peace Officers Standards and Training Council. Applicants must be able to pass a background check.

The starting salary will depend on experience but is anticipated to range from \$18.25 to **18.50 hourly**. A competitive benefit package with PERSI retirement and **paid family insurance and a local Gym membership for the family**.

The last day to submit an application is on October 5th, 2020 by 5:00 PM. **A city application must be completed in order to be considered.** An application form can be picked up at Rupert Police Department, 633 Fremont Ave, Rupert, Idaho or obtained from the City's website at www.rupert-idaho.com.
